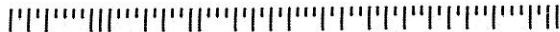

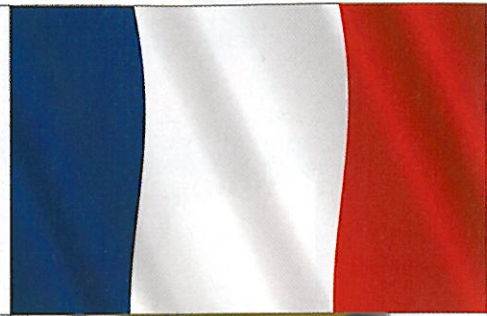

WORLDLY WINES

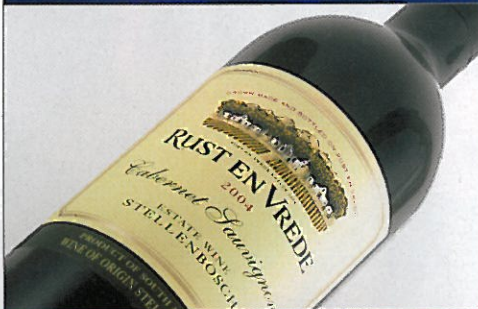
These six wines from around the world will have you sipping the good stuff like an international jet setter.



Chateau Lassegue Pink Crique 2007, Saint Emilion, France Not your ordinary Rosé, this old vine wine captures the area's limestone and sandy terroir, and shows lovely berry fruit. I'm seeing the *Sex and the City* girls putting their cosmos down for a glass of this. \$15



Kim Crawford 2008 Unoaked Chardonnay, New Zealand The Kiwi Nation's wines are clean and vibrant, with heaps of tropical fruit. No mucking up with barrel fermentation here; let the grapes speak for themselves. Down with Aussie Chard! \$17



Rust En Vrede Cabernet Sauvignon 2004, Stellenbosch, South Africa In the land of Cape Buffalo, the last thing you'd expect is exceptional wine. But there's nothing gamy about this elegant bottle, which has a huge tannin structure. Exotic chocolate-tobacco notes waft over this dark red. \$27



2006 Laurenz V. "Charming" Grüner Veltliner, Kamptal, Austria An unexpected jewel from the land yodeling and lederhosen, we were blown away by the combo of ripe apple aromas and Veltliner spiciness. This is the "Sound of Music" in a glass. \$25



Recoleta Malbec Bonarda 2007, Mendoza, Argentina All you Fresh & Easy geeks have already discovered this one. Pick up a party pack, two bottles of this zesty red, and invite the neighbors over. Or heck, get a case! For only \$5 a bottle, we love the overall drinkability and earthy Cab-like fruit.
